



GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES FOR ATTENDING MASS

Your Mass attendance at Saint Dennis is at your own discernment. If you would be putting yourself or others at risk by attending Mass, we ask that you remain away from the celebration of Mass for the safety of all involved. We offer the following for attending Mass at Saint Dennis:

- Your obligation to attend Mass remains removed.
- Weekend Mass schedule is: Saturday at 4 pm, and Sundays at 7:30 am, 9 am, and 10:45 am.
- Daily Mass is being held in the church Monday-Friday at 8 am.
- Online at 9! Online Mass is still available every Sunday at 9:00 am on our website and Facebook page.
- If you are 65 and older, have an underlying health condition or compromised immune system, or are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, we ask you to please stay safe at home and watch Mass online.
- Online giving is encouraged. Offertory baskets will also be available or you may send your donation to the church office.
- Households may sit together in the pews.
- Use physical distancing at all times. Walk or sit at least 6 feet apart from the person or family next to you.
- There will be no singing at Masses.
- There will be no social congregating before or after Mass.
- Enter and exit the church through the back parking lot entrance only. Doors will be propped open to limit "touchpoints."
- At the conclusion of Mass, we will begin exiting with the back pews and continue to the front, all while maintaining a safe distance.
- Wearing a mask is strongly encouraged.
- Hand sanitizer will be available.
